



Y&T Fee Payment – Methods & Terms of Payment

Fees:

£182 per term
Concessionary rate £140 per term**
Joining fee £15

Method of payment:

1. Cash
2. Cheque - payable to Young and Talented
(Returned cheques will incur a £15.00 admin charge).
3. BACS into the Young & Talented bank account. See details below:

Payments made to the account must be referenced with the initials YT and the members' name. e.g. 'YT Luke Skywalker'.
All bank payments need to be received and cleared in the Y&T account in advance. Please check with your bank how long it takes for the funds to clear so as not to miss the clearance date.

All fees are to be paid prior to the member attending the session. If fees are not paid in advance members will not be permitted to attend the session.

Missed sessions:

There are no refunds for missed sessions.

T-Shirts:

It is compulsory for each student to purchase and wear a Y&T branded T-shirt costing £8

Signing in:

Everyone must sign in at reception before going through to the studios.

Late pick up charge:

If your child is not collected by 1.45pm there will be an on the spot charge of £5. Plus £5 for every 15 minutes (or part of) after that.

Contact Details:

Y&T must have your up to date contact details.

Installment Policy:

Under exceptional circumstances it will be possible to break the term's fees into two or more more installments. However, this will be at the discretion of the management after an interview to assess whether you understand your legal responsibilities for getting the fees paid. We are generally very sympathetic to families who cannot afford the fees all at once and would not want children not to be able to attend because of financial circumstances. However, we do not receive regular funding and are a not-for-profit organisation and rely on the fees to run the service. We have to be satisfied that you will keep to your commitment of paying the fees by the agreed dates.

**Concessions are available to those in receipt of housing benefit, council tax benefit, income-based job seekers allowance, incapacity benefit or severe disablement allowance. Proof to be dated no more than 3 months. Proof to be provided at the beginning of each full term.
